# 1. TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR FLOOD-LINE DETERMINATION AND RE-SUBMISSION OF TOURISM DEVELOPMENT AT NTENETYANA DAM

#### 1. BACKGROUND AND OVERVIEW OF THE PROJECT

#### 1.1 INTRODUCTION

The Umzimvubu Local Municipality is within Alfred Nzo District Municipality (ANDM) which is located in the North-Eastern part of the Eastern Cape Province in South Africa, as shown in Figure 1.1 below. The District forms part of the Eastern Cape Province's boundary with the Kwa-Zulu Natal province. The District borders the Kingdom of Lesotho to the north and the district of OR Tambo in the Eastern Cape and Harry Gwala District in Kwa-Zulu Natal. The Umzimvubu Local Municipality is constituted amongst the four local municipalities within the ANDM, others being Matatiele, Mbizana and Ntabankulu Local Municipalities.

The locality of ULM is faced with a great number of socio-economic challenges. The region is characteristic of high poverty and unemployment levels and low education and skills level.

According to the Tourism Sector Plan, tourism has been identified as one of the high potential sectors for ULM. The District possesses potential in tourism related opportunities as a result of a number of attributes namely its rich history, heritage and culture including untouched natural resources in the form of wetlands, forestry, water front parks, spring water etc. have been well profiled in the Tourism Sector plan. Given that the District has developed a detailed understanding of its local tourism potential through the Tourism Sector plan of the District, further scope and opportunity for development is now being pursued for a number of initiatives.

Therefore in line with identified potential for tourism the Umzimvubu Local Municipality has identified Ntenetyana Dam as an area with great potential for tourism.

Ntenetyana Dam is an existing water resource under the administration and management of ANDM. This dam provides water supply to ANDM households for household consumption however given that the dam represents already established and quite a number of activities, opportunity for tourism development at this dam have been identified.

Location: The Ntenetyana Dam is situated at the following geographical coordinates:  $28^{\circ}56'23.77''E$ ,  $30^{\circ}46'50.984''S$ 

The purpose of the project is to undertake development that will stimulate tourism development at Ntenetyana dam. The anticipated outcome is an increase in visitor numbers and overall tourism development and growth within this sector in ULM.

# 1.2 OVERALL OBJECTIVE AND SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

#### 1.2.1 Overall objective

The overall objective of the project is to stimulate tourism development in ULM which will translate into an increase in visitor numbers, economic growth and development and employment creation within the tourism sector.

#### 1.2.2 Specific Objectives

The specific objectives of the project require the undertaking of the following:

 A flood-line determination and re-submission of an application for an Environmental Impact Assessment for the Ntenetyana Dam Tourism Development project.

#### 2. SCOPE OF WORK

Proposals are invited from suitably qualified professional service providers to prepare and submit proposals to undertake the flood-line determination and re-submission of an application for an Environmental Impact Assessment for the Ntenetyana Dam Tourism Development project

The project time frame will be 2 months from the date of appointment of the service provider.

The project proposal must contain the following:

 Undertaking of a flood-line determination and re-submission of an application for an Environmental Impact Assessment for the Ntenetyana Dam Tourism Development project. It should be noted it is the responsibility of the service provider to ensure that upon submission of proposals, a valid entity registration document, Tax Clearance Certificate and BBBEE Certificate must be included.

#### 3. KEY OUTPUPTS/PROJECT MILESTONES/DELIVERABLES

The initial project deliverable will be an inception report which will serve as project plan for the implementation of the project.

The overall project output/deliverable is a comprehensive conceptual document which will include the following:

 Undertaking of a flood-line determination and re-submission of an application for an Environmental Impact Assessment for the Ntenetyana Dam Tourism Development project.

#### 4. STAKEHOLDERS CONSULTATION

The successful service provider will be required to undertake the stakeholder consultations and engagements as it is a vital and an ongoing requirement to ensure support buy-in and successful completion of the project. The project proposal should cover how the service provider will approach the component of stakeholder consultation.

#### 5. PROJECT MANAGEMENT

In cases where the appointed service provider appoints the services of other consultants or sub-contractors, the appointed service provider will take responsibility of the work of the sub-contractors. The client will deal with the contracted service provider and not with sub-contracted consultants. The project is to be coordinated and managed by an operational team led by Alfred Nzo District Municipality.

A Project Steering Committee (PSC) made of senior officials and politicians will oversee the project implementation and facilitate inter — governmental coordination. The ongoing plans and progress reports from the service provider will have to be submitted to the Project Operational Team and or Project Steering Committee where a process of verification will take place prior to the approval of invoices submitted by the service provider. Ideally prior to the sitting of a PSC meeting, technical verification must be undertaken by the PSC of work claimed by the service provider in order to ensure that the PSC is in a position to approve claims by the service provider.

### 6. ACCOUNTABILITY AND REPORTING MECHANISM

It is expected that regular progress reports will be presented to the PSC on a monthly basis. The Project Manager has the right to change frequency of reporting as and when necessary. Progress reporting will be undertaken in terms of documented reporting and in presentation format at PSC meetings. The service provider will account to Umzimvubu Local Municipality and Department of

Economic Development and Environmental Management. Project Manager will monitor the process/ progress on the site.

#### 7. SUBMISSION OF BIDS
