- 2. If the bid document is completed using a pencil. Only black ink must be used to complete the bid document.
- 3. The bidder attempts to influence, or has in fact influenced the evaluation and/or awarding of the contract.
- 4. The bid has been submitted after the relevant closing date and time.
- 5. If any bidder who during the last five years has failed to perform satisfactorily on a previous contract with the municipality, municipal entity or any other organ of state after written notice was given to that bidder that performance was unsatisfactory.
- 6. The accounting officer must ensure that irrespective of the procurement process followed, no award may be given to a person
 - (a) who is in the service of the state, or;
