EASY AND SAFE CROSSING FOR COMMUNITIES OF WARD 6

The Welisizwe Rural Bridges Programme is aimed at ensuring that rural communities can go on with their daily lives, and easily and safely reach schools, health facilities, workplaces and other amenities. This is a programme managed by the Department of Public Works and Infrastructure, the South African National Defence Force (SANDF) and provincial Transport Department. Constructed under the transformative Welisizwe Programme, the newly built bridge at Ward 6 in

EmaXesibeni has provided the much-needed aide for residents of Sihlahleni and Welakabini villages respectively. Community members now have safe and reliable access to essential services such as schools and the health care facility. The bridge connects communities to Mwaca local clinic, pupils of Dumisa, Mlungiseleli and Machibini schools. This much needed bridge is improving the livelihoods of the rural communities of Ward 6 and surroundings. The construction of the bridge brought significant social and economic spin-offs to the surrounding community. Approximately 40 people were

employed during the project, providing much-needed jobs and income to local families. This employment not only reduced short-term unemployment but also allowed workers to gain valuable skills and experience in construction and project management. The Umzimvubu Local Municipality Mayor, Cllr Zukiswa Ndevu extends a word of gratitude to the national government through the Department of Public Works & Infrastructure and the South African Defence Force for this provision.


