In a continued effort to be recognised as a model rural municipality with a vibrant economy and world class service delivery capabilities, the Umzimvubu Local Municipality has in the previous financial year (2024 / 2025) invested close to R1 million for the installation of thirty (30) streetlights, through the Infrastructure Development Department.

The Municipality can confirm that in the 2025 / 2026 financial year the same project has been implemented, with installation of more than 65 streetlights nearing completion, close to 45 streetlights have already been installed. Thirteen local people were temporarily employed.

It will also contribute to the fight against crime, as many criminal activities occur after dark”, said Mayor Ndevu. Phakathi kweprojekthi eziphambili eziza kuphunyezwa kulo nyaka-mali kukho

ukufakelwa kombane kwiindawo zaseNgojini, eShayamoya naseSigidini, ezixhaswa yi-INEP Grant exabisa i-R8.4 yezigidi. Kukwakho neprojekthi ezinkulu zeziseko zophuhliso ezixhaswa yiMunicipal Infrastructure Grant (MIG) exabisa i-R57.7 yezigidi, eziquka ukwakhiwa kwebhulorho yaseOsborn, indlela yokungena kunye nebhulorho yaseMarwaqa, iNdllela yokuNgena yaseNgwekazana/Gud-lintaba, kwakunye nokwakhiwa kweeholo zoluntu kwiindawo ezahlukeneyo zalomasipala.
